Important Reminders and Plans of Action for you and your incoming student

1. All incoming students must submit a Final Report Card

by 3:00pm Thursday, June 15, 2017! The deadline has been extended due to many phone calls received from parents who believe that they will not receive final official report cards until mid-June 2017. However, please be mindful that we would really like to receive this information as soon as possible to guarantee the student's final acceptance into Baton Rouge Magnet High School. This applies to **ALL** accepted students (i.e. East Baton Rouge, Private, Parochial, Out of State, etc.).

2. If a student took an End of Course (EOC) test, please submit the student's test scores along with the student's final report card. We understand that PARCC/LEAP scores are not available at this time.

3. Schedule requests can be submitted via email to Mrs. Tiffany Banks, our ninth grade guidance counselor. Her email address is tbanks4@ebrschools.org. Simply type the student's name in the subject line of the email. In the body of the email, indicate what class was initially chosen for the student and what new course has been chosen instead for the student.

4. For those parents that would like to **change a math course despite the school's recommendation from the Math Proficiency test**, you must complete and return a [Parent Waiver](#) indicating which class that you would like the student to take.

5. If a student registered for Human Geography Advanced Placement (Social Studies course) or any other Advanced Placement English or History courses, he or she **may be required** to complete a summer reading assignment. The guidelines for these assignments are being updated at this time. You can check to see what is currently available under the "Admissions" page of our Baton Rouge Magnet High School website.

6. LAST BUT CERTAINLY NOT LEAST, we **strongly encourage** incoming ninth and tenth grade students to begin working on **Accelerated Reader**. Our wonderful librarians have created a **Summer Reading Brochure** that can be found under the "Admissions" tab on the Baton Rouge Magnet High School website. This brochure features several texts that will help students earn points during the first three weeks of the 2017-2018 school year. **It is recommended that each student choose and read at least one nonfiction book and one fiction book during the summer. Take notes about the novel so that he/she can take a test during the first three weeks of school.**
