Eleven former Baton Rouge High School athletes will be inducted into the school's newly revamped Athletic Hall of Fame in a ceremony on May 4th.

They will join the six current members who were inducted in 2005. Those members are Jimmy Taylor, Bob Pettit, Billy Hardin, Warren Rabb, Jenny Streiffer Mascaro and Caesar Garcia.

The organization had been inactive since the 2005 induction, but was revived over the past three years under the leadership of school athletic director Kevin Nee, alumni Johnny Palazzotto, Joe Womack and Butch Helveston, and BRHS coaches Bill Bofinger, Dayna Kohn and Maggie Hall.

This year's class of inductees, all of whom received all-state honors in their respective sports, is led by 3-sport star Bobby Cotten (Class of 1961-football, basketball and baseball).

2-sport inductees are Joe Womack (1965-football and track), Nalinya Davis (1996-volleyball and track), Pablo Presedo (1984-cross country and track), Brad Brian (1963-basketball and baseball), and Kathy Krupa Green (1992-soccer and cross country).

Others are David Poche (1962-football), Mike Smith (1966-football), Sarah Benson (2006-soccer), John Zeringue (1984-gymnastics), and Arthur "J" Boudreaux (1992-gymnastics).

The May 4th ceremony will begin at 2:30 p.m. in the school's foyer with a meet-and-greet social time followed by the induction in the auditorium. The public is invited to attend.
